#### **Course Objectives/Outcomes:**

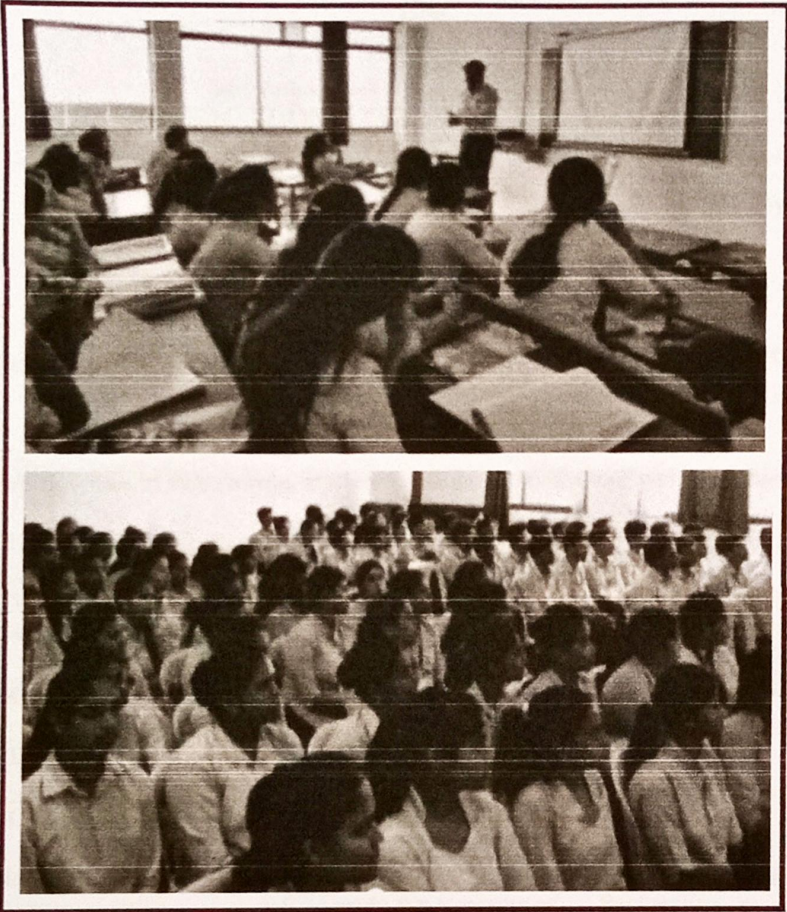
The objective of this course is student will be able to acquire knowledge and understand basics of communication and soft skills.

- 4) Familiarize soft skills including pronunciation basics and it's importance.

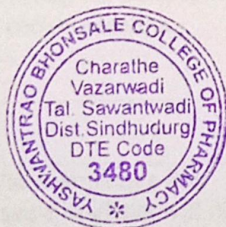
#### **About the program: -**
