Objectives of the Event

- ✓ To encourage students about professional education.
- ✓ To raise awareness about opportunities and the scope of Pharmacy education.
- ✓ To educate students about the Centralized Admission Process.
- ✓ To improve the enrollment of rural students in Pharmacy courses.
- ✓ To inform students about eligibility criteria, required documents, and available scholarships for Pharmacy admission.

About the Program:

Bhonsale Knowledge City and Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy, Sawantwadi, have been organizing the School Connect Campaign every year. This program is aimed at encouraging students, particularly those residing in the rural areas of Sindhudurg, to pursue Pharmacy education.

The campaign spanned two weeks, during which a committee of experienced faculty members was formed. The faculties were divided into various groups, and each group was assigned to visit different HSC colleges in the Sindhudurg district.

During their visits, the faculty members guided the students on the following aspects of pharmacy education and admissions:

- ✓ Scope and Opportunities: Career opportunities available in the Pharmacy profession.
- ✓ Admission Process: Minimum qualifications required, eligibility criteria, and the Centralized Admission Process.
- ✓ Scholarships and Financial Support: Availability of government scholarships, procurement of educational loans, and other financial aids.
- ✓ Facilities and Infrastructure: Hostel and transportation facilities, as well as the infrastructure and learning opportunities at Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy.
- ✓ Job Prospects: Career paths and job opportunities in the pharmacy field after completing the courses.

The campaign provided an in-depth exploration of various critical aspects of Pharmacy education. It began with a focus on career opportunities in the Pharmacy profession, discussing the wide range of roles that Pharmacists can pursue in healthcare, research, and the pharmaceutical industry. The session also highlighted the minimum qualifications required for pharmacy admissions, guiding students on the necessary academic background and entrance exam requirements for pursuing Pharmacy courses.

Additionally, the campaign covered the available Pharmacy courses, detailing different undergraduate and postgraduate programs that can be pursued in the field of pharmacy, including B. Pharm, M. Pharm, and specialized courses. Finally, the session addressed the scope of Pharmacy education, emphasizing the diverse career paths, job prospects, and opportunities for professional growth in the ever-evolving field of Pharmacy.

The Pharmacy Education Campaign achieved its objective of spreading awareness about pharmacy education among HSC students in Sindhudurg district. Such initiatives play a crucial role in bridging the gap between rural students and professional education opportunities. It is recommended to continue organizing similar campaigns in the future to further enhance awareness and enrollment in pharmacy courses.

After completion of college-to-college visit, we have conducted a NEP - 2020 awareness and open discussion program on Saturday, 27th December 2024 to aware the faculty members and students about guidelines of National Education Policy 2020 design and recommended by UGC, India. For the said program Professor, Dr. Manish Joshi, Secretory. UGC were present as a Chief Guest. Prof. Dr. Manish Joshi sir focused on various aspects of NEP-2020 such as Basically, the education policy is not made with the expectation of changing the education system completely, but to improve it. Collaborative education is one of the major aspect in it. A student who wants to learn the subject he wants to learn can take the guidance he needs wherever it is available. Also, without making a complete change in the education system, the institutions should make whatever changes are necessary and can be implemented through the university. For this, the universities should establish a National Education Policy Support Cell and guide the colleges in this regard. The educational policy is expected to be comprehensive. Choice-based or parallel planning of subjects according to the student's interests is a matter that comes under the jurisdiction of the college and can be resolved through the group university. The role of the university is very important in this.
