The GPAT score is accepted by all AICTE- approved Institutions/University Departments/Constituent Colleges/Affiliated Colleges.

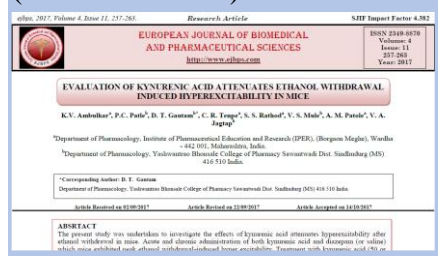

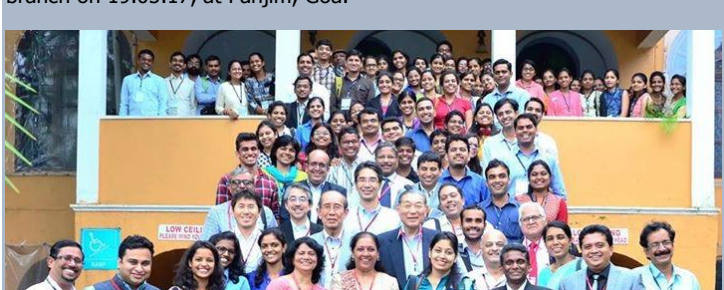

Machine Room Expansion at YBCP

YBCP established and expanded its machine room and aseptic room on Saturday, 14th October 2017. On this occasion, KARNAVATI Make 10MT (5D and 5B) stations Mini Press II 'B' multi-tooling along with Electro-lab Make auto 8 station Dissolution Test Apparatus were installed and inaugurated. Along with new Laminar Air Flow cabinet (8x2x2) made up of stainless steel complete with HEPA filter having efficacy of 99.97% down on 0.3% microns and Pre-filter 90% down to 5% microns, suitable motor blowing assemblies, working table with stainless steel top, side acrylic panel, fluorescent tube lights and pressure differential manometer and castor wheels. U. V. Light and gas cork 7 plexi doors in metallic construction with attractive epoxy powder coating finish equipped in aseptic room with advanced industrial level setup.

Inauguration of machine room was done by Hon. Executive Chairman of BKC, Shri Achyut Sawantbhonsale while aseptic room was inaugurated by Hon. Admin. Coordinator Mrs. Sunetra Phatak in the presence of Hon. Principal Dr. Vijay Jagtap and HOD of pharmaceuticals department Mr. Sanket Gandhi, Asst. Prof. Dept. of Pharmaceutics.

Demonstration and information of all the sections like tablet section, granulation section, QC section, IPQC section, along with aseptic cabinet, changing room, washing room were given by Mr S. K. Gandhi and T. Y. B. Pharmacy students.

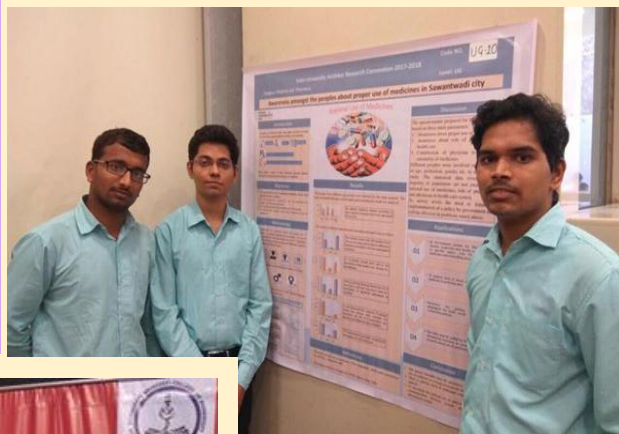
In this event parents also shared their views, ideas, thoughts and appreciated the college for organizing different professional and curricular activities during this year.
