## **"BLOOD CHECK UP CAMP "**

Health is always priority concern in human being. The day by day unhealthy population of hypertension, diabetes, anaemia, like are increasing. Many people are not even considering certain small alarming indication shown by body regarding these illness. These are non-contagious diseases but can be life threatening if neglected and not treated. People usually have least awareness about the different blood parameters ,its regular check up and most of them have to face a difficult health situation.

By considering this fact Virendra Athlekar and his friend circle along with **Yashwantrao Bhonsale college of pharmacy** and Arya pathological Laboratory have organised FREE BLOOD CHECK UP CAMP at Panwal ,Degve on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2018, Sunday. The camp was inaugurated by auspicious hands of Mr.Ashutosh Bhangle, a journalist. Present visitors were wel come by Mr.Amit PArashtekar. The huge response was there for camp including all age group. The different blood parameters like blood group, bleeding time ,clotting time, haemoglobin level, blood pressure were checked by S.Y.B.Pharmacy students by using ABO method, blotting method , capillary method, Sahlis heamoglobinometer, and sphegmomanometer respectively. Blood sugar both fasting and post prandial was checked by Mrs.Santoshi Kolambkar Dhuri Pathology technician Arya Pathological Laboratory. Students of second year B.Pharmacy were guided by Mr.Tanmay Patwardhan (Asst. Professor in Pharmacology), Ms.Kavita Chavan (Asst. Professor in Pharmaceutics) and Ms.Shweta Shirodkar (Asst. Professor in Pharmaceutics).

Camp was started at 8.00 AM with fasting blood sugar checkup. After the schedule was continued with blood group determination, haemoglobin level checkup, bleeding time, clotting time, blood pressure measurement, BMI calculation and post prandial blood glucose level.





Throughout the camp the counselling was made by students regarding diet and exercise for the people who had low haemoglobin count, high blood sugar level, high blood pressure and high BMI. The queries of patients were cleared. The beneficiary population included children, youngsters along with age old people.





Total 104 patients were registered for blood check-up camp. At the ending total 7 patients with high blood pressure and 2 patients with high post prandial blood sugar were found. The confirmation was done by repeat examination of blood pressure and blood sugar. The huge response was observed for the camp. The people appreciated the efforts taken by students for arranging camp. Program was compering by Mr.Virendra Athlekar. Program was concluded by vote of thanks proposed by Mr.Shashikant Pitre.

Dr. V. A. Jagtap, Principal Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy provided complete support and guidance for the successful and disciplined arrangement for the camp . He expressed his future perspective for organization of more such camps for beneficiary of society.
