

Introduction:



Objectives:


- 1. To learn the importance of books.

- 3. To encourage students to observe their reading or study pattern.


About the Program:




1. Genderwise students interested in Survey









4. Books category in which students interested to read






6. Favourite place for reading

Conclusion of Survey:

After analyzing the survey data total following outcome has been observed which are stated below:

- 1. There is 61.9% female participant participated in survey where only 37.1 % male participated in this survey. This data shows that female students are more interested towards reading, survey like activity.
- 2. Students have given more than fifteen titles as their favorite books among of them top most five books are as follow-most favorite book of more than twenty student is Wings Of Fire, then second most favorite is The Secret, Alchemist, Pharmaceutics textbook, Essential of Pharmacology, Bhagvat Geeta, Shyamchi aai
- 3. Most favorite author of student is former president of India Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam then at second position Ronda Byrne. From this committee observe that life lessons of great missile man can be used to motivate the students.
- 4. Most of the students are interested in reading biography of great personalities. This data shows that by adding a chapter with story of great scientist, great personality and student interest can be improved in academics.
- 5. The first choice of student for reading is Marathi, second one is English. So by using both languages one for explanation & second for scripting about that topic will give an improved understanding of that topic.
- 6. Home is stated as best place for study and reading by the students, on second position library is good place for study.
- 7. 74% of student still prefers print books for reading while only 18% students use eBooks, 8% student prefer both mode for reading.
- 8. At the end of survey the data shows that 26.8% students have regular reading practice while 34%- 57.7% students only reads 1-3 times a day.

Here students interest, his/her preferred author, genera, language should be taken into consideration to improves their reading habit. By using story telling techniques ,connecting the dots of syllabus, textbook , current technology students interested can be enhanced. To achieve this goal students should remain well connected to library and books. That will help them to open up their minds towards science & learning.
