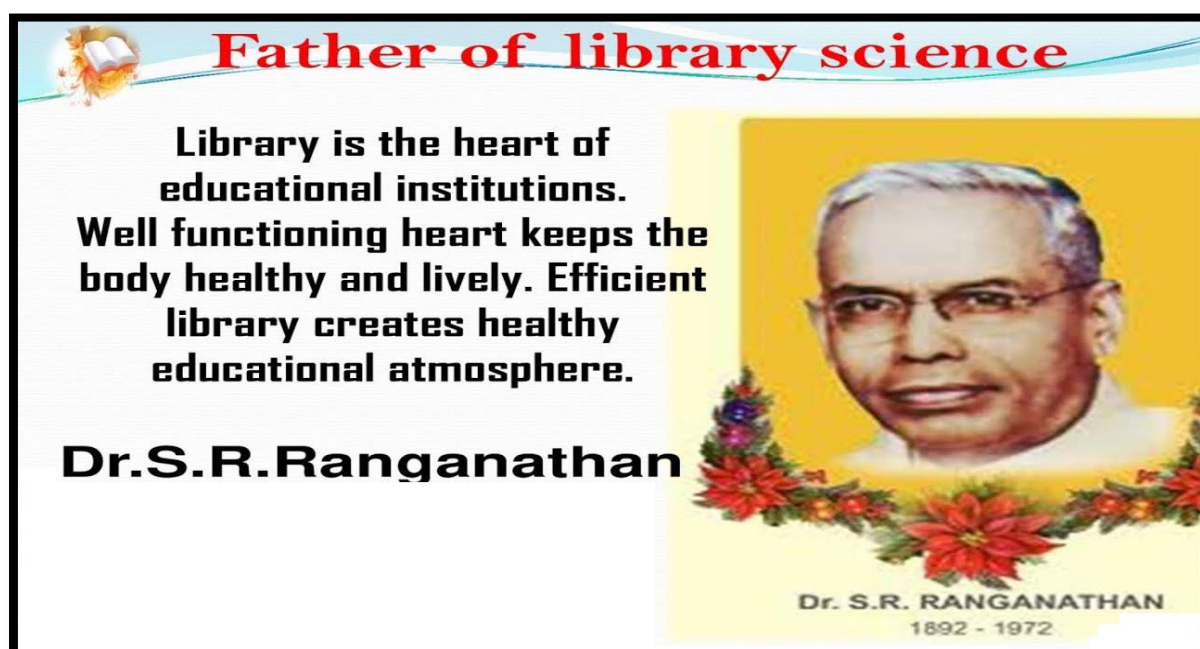




## Kaleidoscopic report National Librarian's Day
