Introduction –

Bal Keshav Thackeray (also known as Balasaheb Thackeray; 23 January 1926 – 17 November 2012) was an Indian politician who founded the Shiv Sena, a right-wing pro-Marathi and Hindu nationalist party active mainly in the state of Maharashtra.

Thackeray began his professional career as a cartoonist but he left the paper in 1960 to form his own political weekly. His political philosophy was largely shaped by his father Keshav Sitaram Thackeray, a leading figure in the Samyukta Maharashtra (United Maharashtra) movement, which advocated the creation of a separate linguistic state for Marathi speakers.

Through *Marmik*, Bal Thackeray campaigned against the growing influence of non-Marathis in Bombay. In 1966, Thackeray formed the Shiv Sena party to advocate for the interests of Maharashtra in Bombay India political and professional landscape. Balasaheb Thackeray died on 17 November 2012, of cardiac arrest. So, on the day of his remembrance Smruti Gandh program was organized by Balasaheb Thackrey Study Centre.

Objectives:-

1. To give tribute to Balasaheb Thackrey
2. To participate in the campaign against the nonmarthi people in Mumbai.

About the program:-

Smruti Gandh program was organized by Balasaheb Thackrey Study Centre. A webinar was arranged for the same. As it is NSS activity, all the NSS volunteers were requested to attend the same.
