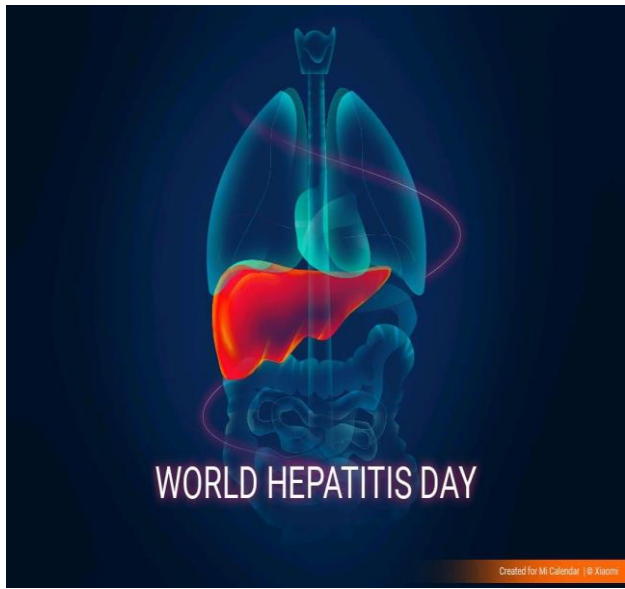

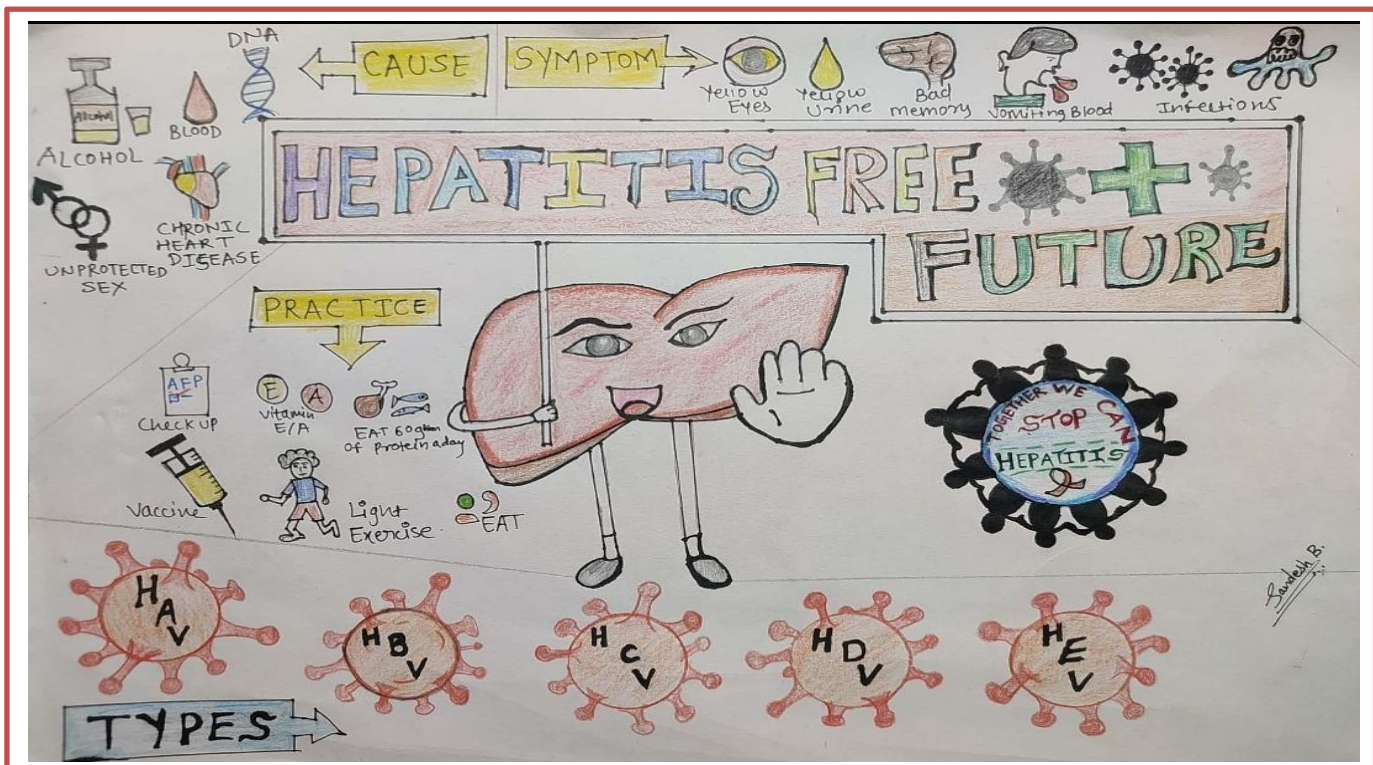

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT HEPATITIS????

Hepatitis:- Hepatitis is a serious liver disease caused by the hepatitis virus. Due to which it can make you very sick, and lead to hospitalization and sometimes death.

How Is HEPATITIS SPREAD?

- forgetting to Wash hands after using Washrooms.
- Having Sex With Infected Person.
- Eating or Drinking Foods Contaminated with hepatitis.

SYMPTOMS:

- Yellowing of Eyes, And Skin (Jaundice)
- Fever.
- Nausea or vomiting up.

HIGH RISK FACTOR

High Risk People:

- People who use injected and non-injected drugs.
- People experiencing homelessness/homelessness.
- People with direct contact with someone who already has hepatitis.
- Travelers.
- People who visit or those who are recently incarcerated.

TYPES :-

A, B, C, D, E

TRANSMISSION :-

- Sharing personal hygiene items
- Sharing eating and drinking
- Using non-sterile equipment for tattoos
- Exposure to body fluid of an infected person (e.g. sexual intercourse, mother to child during birth, ...)
- Unsafe healthcare practices

SYMPTOMS :-

- Yellowing of the skin and eyes
- Dark urine
- Abdominal pain
- Nausea and vomiting
- Fatigue and Exhaustion
- Loss of appetite

TREATMENT :-

- Supportive Care
- Rest and good fluids
- Antiviral medications
- A nutritious high-calorie diet
