

3. This day is dedicated to the role young women and men play in bringing change in tackling global issues and achieving sustainable development.


4. It also serves as an opportunity to raise awareness of challenges and problems facing the world's youth.

# **ABOUT THE PROGRAM :-**


On the occasion of International Youth Day, a webinar was organized for the students with the theme 'Transforming Food Systems: Youth Innovation for Human'


