


HEPATITIS A
Spreads through the faeces of an infected person.
Transmitted by unsafe water, poor hygiene, inadequate sanitation.

HEPATITIS B
Can be life-threatening
Increases the risk of cirrhosis and liver cancer.
Transmitted through blood and other body fluids.

HEPATITIS C
Caused by the Hepatitis C virus
Can be mild to severe, lasting from a few weeks to lifelong.
Transmitted via infected needles, unsterilized medical equipment, infected blood.

HEPATITIS D
Can happen to those infected with Hepatitis A virus.
Getting vaccinated for Hepatitis B prevents you from Hepatitis D.

HEPATITIS E
Transmitted through contaminated drinking water
Can last from 4 to 6 weeks
It can be fatal

- Expand access to testing and treatment at time of the viral hepatitis can prevent liver cancer and other severe liver disease
- Maintain the essential service for hepatitis during the covid-19 prevention and care service for infant immunization, harm reduction services essential even during pandemic.
