

Objective:

• The main objective of the camp is to create awareness among the people about eye health.

Outcome:

• To improve access to eye health care services.

About the program:

Free Eye Checkup Camp had been organized by Department of Lifelong Learning and extension in collaboration with I CARE OPTICS AND CONTACT LENS CLINICS. The objective of this camp is early detection of ailments, and to detect refractive errors and provide corrective glasses. The camp was organized on 20th December 2022 at Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy. The inauguration was done by principal Dr Vijay A Jagtap. It was followed by the introduction and welcome of the chief guest.

85 Candidates participated in Eye Checkup camp. An eye examination was carried out by anoptometrist Mr. Nitin Naik. As well as testing the sight, the optometrist will check the health of the eyes and look for signs of general health problems. The eyes were examined using an Auto refractor, which is a computer-controlled machine that provide an objective measurement of a person's refractive error and prescription for glasses or contact lenses. This is achieved by measuring how light is changed as it enters a person's eye. The Optometrist also done Eye Examination manually by using Snellen chart. After the eye examination, the optometrist has been given detailed knowledge of the health of the eyes, the standard of the vision and any special requirements.


