About the program

The distinguished guests interacted with the audience in a simplistic manner, ensuring that every student and individual present could comprehend the information. This event marked the 11th part of their Democratic talk series held on our campus. The program began with an introduction session, followed by a felicitation ceremony and floral welcome. The discussion then moved to the topic of "Voting," delving into rights and eligibility.

As this segment of the program approached its conclusion, we distributed pieces of paper to the audience for them to write down their questions. These were then collected and randomly posed to the guests. Breakfast and water were provided to the audience, NSS members, and faculty. The members collaborated to distribute lunch boxes, prioritizing the guests and audience, and they were the last to eat lunch.

The success of the entire program hinged on the support of each other and teamwork. Games like snakes and ladders were arranged with rules related to voter rights and their importance. Photo booths were set up to make the session more interactive, and street plays were performed on the college campus.


