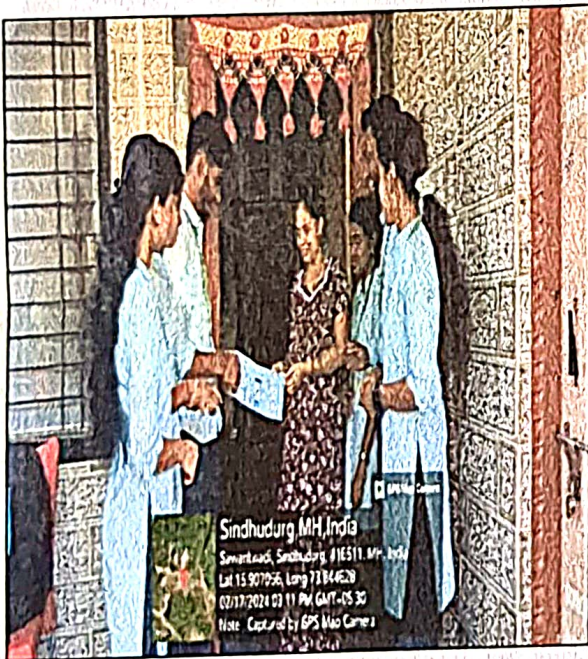
Aabha Card:

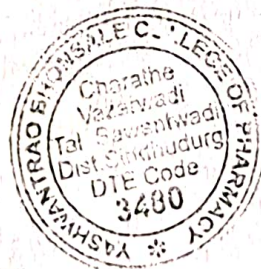
