### **About the Program:**

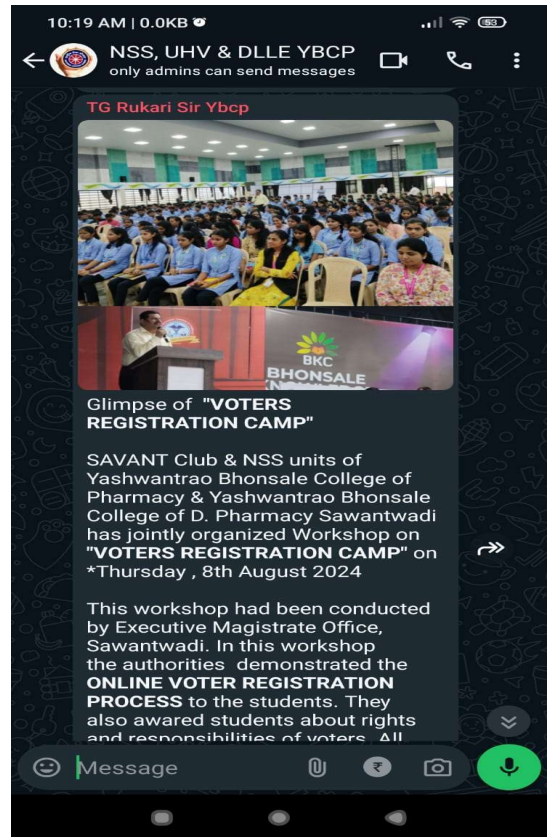
