- Advocate for the right of every girl to receive quality education and career opportunities.
- Spread awareness about harmful practices such as female foeticide, child marriage, and gender bias.
- Educate communities on the significance of empowering girls to become independent and self-reliant.

About the Activity :

On 17th January 2025 group of 12 students visited at Sawantwadi and participated in the Awareness program about human rights (save girl child) in Sawantwadi. Organized by the DLLE Unit of the college. Our “Save Girl Child” awareness activity aimed to educate people about the importance of gender equality and protecting the rights of girls. The activity focused on issues such as female foeticide, child marriage, gender discrimination, and the need for equal opportunities in education and healthcare. Through public discussions, and interactive sessions, we encouraged communities to support and empower girls. We also provided information on legal protections and how to report violations of girls’ rights. The initiative helped raise awareness about the value of the girl child and inspired people to work towards a society where girls are respected, educated, and given equal opportunities to succeed. We also engaged with parents, educators, and local leaders to emphasize the importance of educating and nurturing girls, ensuring they receive the same opportunities as boys. Pamphlets were distributed with information about laws protecting girls’ rights, such as the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme and laws against child marriage and gender-based violence. Additionally, we encouraged people to report any violations of girls’ rights and seek legal help when needed. The initiative received a positive response from the community, with many pledging to support the

cause and work towards a future where girls are treated with dignity, given equal opportunities, and can lead empowered lives. Our efforts aimed to create lasting change by inspiring people to take action and ensure a brighter future for every girl.
