About the program:

As a part of the important academic activities, Visit to Medicinal garden and Ayurvedic Rassshala was arranged for the 1st year students of Yashwantrao Bhonsale college of Pharmacy on 19th December 2024. A batch of 62 students along with a faculty member had visited the hospital. The visit coordinated by Mrs. S. A. Madgaonkar under the guidance of Dr. Vijay Jagtap, Principal, Yashwantrao Bhonsale College of Pharmacy. The visit started after taking attendance of students at College. We boarded the college bus to reach to Sawantwadi. We reached there around 10:30 am.

A group of students was made and then a visit to the different departments of the Rasshala like Production section, filling section, etc. A detailed explanation regarding each department, methods of preparation of Ayurvedic dosage forms and their storage condition, Marketed preparations of Ayurvedic dosage forms and their therapeutic efficacy was given during the visit by Hon. Dr. Sitavar sir Associate professor of Rasshastra. In the end, we visited the medicinal garden. During visit to medicinal garden all the students along with lecturers gain lot of information about all the medicinal plants existed in the garden. Well Trained guide Mr. Butte and Hon. Dr. Sitavar sir Associate professor of Rasshastra from the garden presented so many aspects of all the medicinal plants to the students. Various kinds of plants that we come across are: Amla. Beheda, Adhatoda, Allium, Aloe, Asgandh, Cannabis, Cardamom, Clove, Common lavender, Coriander, Daruhaldi, Datura herb, Fennel, Green Tea, Periwinkle, Rakta Chandan, Rauwolfia, Sarpagandha, Sallakiguggul, Zingiber, Capsicum, Davana herb etc. During the visit, all the students practically come to know well about morphology of the various medicinally plants as well as essential pharmacognostical information about the plants.
