- Enhance urban biodiversity: Contribute to the enhancement of urban biodiversity by providing a vital resource for birds and other wildlife.
- Encourage community involvement: Engage local residents, schools, and community groups in the initiative, promoting a sense of ownership and responsibility for bird conservation.

About the Activity :

On 28th January 2025, a Bird Watering Initiative was successfully conducted at Charathe, Sawantwadi to provide fresh water sources for birds during the dry season. This initiative aimed to support local bird populations, raise awareness about bird conservation, and encourage community participation in environmental sustainability. Volunteers and organizers set up multiple water pots at various locations, including trees, rooftops, and open spaces where birds frequently visit. The initiative provided clean drinking water for a variety of bird species, including sparrows, bulbuls, mynas, and pigeons.

The awareness campaign motivated locals to take small steps toward bird conservation. Plans were discussed to expand the initiative by installing more water stations and involving more communities.
